business description: Razzano Castle (a noble residence) was built in 1697 by Giovan Battista Gaetano Natta, commander of the "Royal Monferrat" infantry regiment, serving King Louis XIV of France. Fine wines are aged in the castle's cellars, while the courtyard houses the Razzano Art and Wine Museum, an art exhibition.

Razzano Castle is part of the Castelli Aperti (Open Castles) program.
